VOYAGER VILLAGE AIRPORT RUNWAY INCURSION SAFETY RULES

- The runway is solely provided for aircraft operations. Use of the runway for activities not necessary for the support of aircraft or grounds maintenance operations is a violation and could cause danger to life and property.
- Safety stickers (shown below) will be required on all golf carts, rental and private, as well course
 maintenance equipment. Please look for and observe the safety caution signs (shown below) posted along the
 runway.
- 3. All forms of lengthwise travel on the runway or inside the runway lights are prohibited. Crossing the runway at 90 degrees is permitted only after observing the (STOP/LOOK/LISTEN/LOOK AGAIN) safety rule.
- 4. Golf balls played onto or across the runway are considered <u>Out of Bounds</u> and may not be played from there.
- 5. Golf carts must be parked on the outside of the runway lights while playing golf. Standing, walking or taking of pictures in the grassy area between the runway lights and runway pavement to better view aircraft during take off and landing is prohibited.
- 6. Ours is a very narrow runway compared to most airports. The grassy area between the runway and runway lights adds a safety factor for pilots and those on the ground during windy or gusty conditions. This area provides safety clearance during taxing, take-off and landing and must be avoided.
- 7. An adult must accompany children at all times while in the vicinity of parked aircraft.

Please help us in educating our members, family, friends and visitors about these safety policies to ensure a safe recreational season for our fly-in guests, golfers and outdoor enthusiasts patronizing our community's amenities during this season.
